## Structured Listening Albums

Structured Listening Albums contain all the elements of music. They support the quiet-alert state and can be used to enhance regulation. They also can have a positive impact on attention and focus and can assist in blocking out background noise. These albums are less intense than modified albums, so they can be used for sensitive individuals prior to starting a modulated program. Structured Listening albums can be used with headphones to manage background distractions and to support fine motor and gross visual-motor activities.
